Incident Commander - Initial Response \$125

The hands on guide to the first Incident Commander on scene. 3 day class.

This course will prepare the new IC as well as the more experienced to deal with the initial event and show by clear examples and exercises how to arrive, take charge and execute a full Search & Rescue Mission.

This is a vital course for any SAR Incident Commander or Deputy.
Certificate course.

SAR TECH II – review and testing \$150

This session is designed for those needing the NASAR SARTECH II testing – written and field.

A review session will be held on Friday and testing be on Saturday and Sunday.

This testing will follow the NASAR standards for all aspects of the testing; written test, pack test, navigation, field search requirements.

Command & General

Staff Class for SAR Overhead Teams. \$125

This class is patterned after the Colorado state Type 3 All Hazards Command and Staff Class. Students will manage a complex search incident using the Incident Command System.

Students will be expected to be familiar with the Incident Command System and will be asked (collectively) to perform functions needed to manage the incident.

Near the end of the exercise, the simulation IMT will be asked to prepare and conduct a management transition to turn the incident over to another management team, such as the CSRB overhead team.



If you have several SAR IMT members on your team, here's an opportunity to practice managing a complex incident as a group.

If not, it'll be a great opportunity to form management groups from different SAR teams and gain experience working with those from other teams!



Plans Section Chief - SAR

Full hands on training !! \$285

Planning Section Chief : Search and Rescue is a management level course teaching the knowledge and techniques needed to perform as Planning Section Chief on any SAR Operation managed under NIMS ICS. It deals with SAR Strategy development, POA and POD calculations in planning and evaluating the search. The course also covers the Situation Unit, Resource Unit, Documentation Unit and Demobilization Unit.

Prerequisites: MLPI, MLSO or MSF; (NIMS) I-200, I-300 will also be very helpful.

The Colorado Search and Rescue Board's Search and Rescue Management Academy (SARMA) is back. Our program this year will include 4 different programs;

Plans Section Chief - 24 hour class from the National Association for Search and Rescue (NASAR) - the job functions of Plans Section Chief in modern search and rescue missions. Class includes creating a written Incident Action Plan and the Documentation Unit. Written test and NASAR certification available following successful completion. Instructor - Dan Hourihan, currently serving as President of the National Association for Search and Rescue. Maximum class size - 20.

Command and General Staff - Search and Rescue - putting the nuts and bolts together for managing a complex search and rescue mission over multiple days. Students will each take assigned roles from the Command and General Staff positions. Program designed to emulate the Colorado Type Three IMT training programs for Command and General Staff. Lead Instructor - Barry Mitchell, Senior Search and Rescue Coordinator for the Colorado Search and Rescue Board

Incident Command - Initial Response - 3 day class on setting up a search and rescue mission - presented by Colorado Search and Rescue Board staff using a model presented by Emergency Response International. Lead Instructor George Janson from Larimer County Search and Rescue team. Maximum Class size - 20.

SARTECH II - review and testing - field and classroom - meeting the National Association of Search and Rescue (NASAR) testing criteria - both field and written test. Lead Instructor Kim Veitch from El Paso County Search and Rescue Team.

Registration is enclosed. Register by mail or fax. Credit Cards accepted. Make as many copies of the registration form that you need.

Some classes have size limitations. Classes will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. Registrations must include payments, unless prior arrangement have been made.

Check-in will be available on Thursday July 14, 2011 starting at 4 pm in Gunnison on the campus of the Western State College. Room and meal plans will be similar to prior years. Classes begin at 8:00 am Friday morning and run thru Sunday afternoon.
