- Texas Shuttle Mission
 - Wildland firefighters used for search
 - 1st two weeks was handled by local agencies.

- Texas forest service was Incident Commander of record.
- Federalized on 15 February.
- Tom Minor in from Washington.
- Performed test searches to decide on POD. Decided on 50-75% for 1 foot to 2 foot objects.
- CSRB provided SAR instructors.
- There were some non-English speaking crews.
- NASA divided into grid of 2 degrees by 2 degrees. 4 miles by 240 mile area searched by ground crews.
- \$200 million cost for search.
- Found 38% of shuttle by weight.
- Astronauts found in Texas near the Texas/Louisiana border. Estimated 98% of remains found.
- Larimer, Douglas, RMR and Alpine sent people.
- Larimer: 28 missions so far
- Douglas: 27 mission so far.
